DENTAL CENTER

CincySmiles Dental Center provides dental treatment to anyone needing services with special attention to the most at-risk populations of the Greater Cincinnati, Northern Kentucky and SE Indiana area.

DENTAL ROAD CREW (DRC)

The DRC travels to the schools, medical and mental health care facilities, nursing homes, and social service agencies CincySmiles has partnered them to deliver dental treatment and oral health education services onsite using portable dental equipment.

MATERNAL & EARLY CHILDHOOD ORAL HEALTH CARE

The Maternal and Early Childhood Oral Health Care Program provides low-income pregnant women, mothers, and children under the age of six with preventive and restorative dental treatment, along with oral health education.

ORAL HEALTH WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM

CincySmiles Oral Health Workforce Development Program addresses the shortage of providers in underserved areas and the need to increase the number of dental professionals from underrepresented and racially diverse populations. Through hands-on teaching and training opportunities, we strive to prepare them to secure employment and establish

a career in the oral health care industry.
